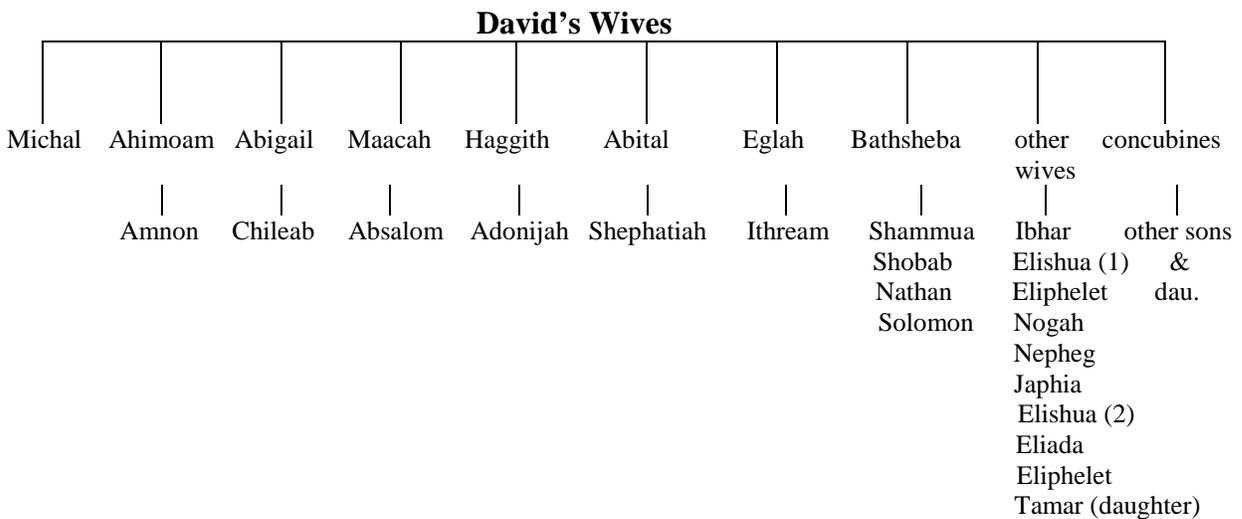

| Birth of Jesus | Jesus begins His ministry | Crucifixion, Resurrection, Ascension of Jesus. Pentecost= Birth of the Catholic (universal) Church | Founding of the Church at Antioch, Syria. St James, kinsman of Jesus, becomes Bishop of the Church in Jerusalem | St Peter founds the Church in Rome. St James Zebedee is martyred | Council of Jerusalem | James, Bishop of Jerusalem, martyred | Sts Peter and Paul martyred in Rome |

| <p>Elders of Israel to David: <i>“In the days past when Saul was our king, it was you who led Israel on its campaigns <u>[you who led out and brought in Israel]</u>, and to you it was that Yahweh promised, ‘<u>You are to shepherd my people Israel and be leader of Israel.</u>’”</i> 2 Sam 5:2-4</p> | <p>Yahweh: <i>I will seek out my sheep and will deliver them from all the places where they were scattered ...And I will gather them from the peoples and will bring them out and gather them in...</i> Ez 34:12-13</p> <p><i>“I shall raise up one shepherd, my servant David, and put him in charge of them to pasture them <u>[and he shall feed them]</u>; he will pasture <u>[feed] them and be their shepherd.</u>”</i> Ez 34:23</p> | <p><i>Jesus Christ, <u>son of David</u> ...</i> Mt 1:1</p> <p>Jesus: <i>“I am the gate of the sheepfold... anyone who enters through me will be safe [saved]: such a one will <u>go in and out</u> and will find pasture <u>[feeding]</u>... <u>I am the good shepherd...</u>”</i> Jn 10:7-9, 15</p> <p>Jesus: <i>“and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world.”</i> (Jn 6:51b)</p> <p><i>“Take it and eat,” he said, “this is my body.</i> Mt 26:26b</p> |
| <p>Yahweh’s judgment of the failure of the Davidic kings: <i>I saw all Israel scattered on the mountains like sheep without a shepherd.</i> 1 Kng 22:17</p> | <p>Yahweh: <i>For lack of a shepherd they have been scattered, to become the prey of all the wild animals; they have been scattered...</i> Ez 34:5</p> <p><i>I myself shall pasture my sheep, I myself shall give them rest, declares the Lord Yahweh. <u>I shall look for the lost one, bring back the stray ... I shall be a true shepherd to them.</u></i> Ez 34:15-16</p> | <p><i>... they were troubled and abandoned like <u>[scattered] sheep without a shepherd.</u></i> Mt 9:26</p> <p><i>He [Jesus] said in reply, “I was sent only to the lost sheep of the House of Israel.”</i> Mt 15:24</p> <p>Jesus: <i>“For the Son of Man has come <u>to save what was lost.</u>”</i> Lk 19:10</p> <p>Jesus: <i>“<u>I am the good shepherd...</u>”</i> Jn 10:15</p> |
| | <p><i>As for you, my sheep, the Lord Yahweh says this: “I shall judge between sheep and sheep, between rams and he-goats.”</i> Ez 34:17</p> | <p><i>When the Son of Man comes in his glory ... All nations will be assembled before him and he will separate people one from another as the shepherd separates sheep from goats.</i> Mt 25:31-32</p> |

David is anointed three times:

1. First he was as a boy privately anointed by Samuel (1 Sam 16:13).
2. Next he was made king over the tribe of Judah (2 Sam 2:4).
3. Finally he was crowned king over a united Israel (2 Sam 5:3).

David’s dynasty ruled over Israel and then Judah for 425 years until the Babylonian conquest.
